

INFORMATION CLAUSE

(general – for the website)

Pursuant to Art. 13.1 and 13.2 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and the repealing of Directive 95/46/EC („GDPR”) pls be advised as follows:

1. The administrator of your personal data is BLACHPROFIL 2 Sp. z o.o. based in Kraków (Cracow), address: 30-527, ul. Nadwiślańska 11/139, with the place of operation in:
 - Grójec, ul. Grojecka 39, 32-566 Alwernia
 - Dąbrowa Górnicza (41-303), ul. Budowlanych 10
2. As the Data Protection Inspector the administrator appointed Ms Wioletta Kaczmarek who can be contacted by email at inspektor@bp2.pl
She can be contacted in all issues relating to the processing of personal data and the enforcement of the related rights.
3. Your data shall be processed under:
 - Art. 6.1.a GDPR, that is the consent of the person involved for their data to be processed for one or more purposes
 - Art. 6.1.b GDPR in order to accomplish the contract which such a person is party to
 - Art. 6.1.c GDPR in order to fulfil the legal duty which the administrator is subject to.
4. The recipient of your personal data shall solely be organizations entitled to be given personal data under the rules of law, and also the organizations cooperating with BLACHPROFIL 2 Sp. z o.o. which under the relevant personal data processing agreements process data on the administrator's behalf.
5. Your personal data shall be stored for a period necessary to accomplish the processing purposes referred to in (3) above, and subsequently – for the necessary backup period provided for in the 14 July 1983 national archive resource and archives act (Journal of Laws no 38 section 173, as amended).
6. You have the right to:
 - access your personal data pursuant to Art. 15 GDPR
 - have your personal data corrected pursuant to Art. 16 GDPR
 - have your personal data removed pursuant to Art. 17 GDPR
 - curtail the processing of your personal data pursuant to Art. 18 GDPR
 - file an objection pursuant to Art. 21 GDPR.
7. Should your personal data be processed under Art. 6.1.a GDPR you shall have the right to withdraw your consent at any moment without affecting the conformity with the right of processing effected with your consent before you withdrew it.
8. You shall have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body, that is the President of the Personal Data Protection Agency based in 00-193 Warsaw, ul. Stawki Street 2, whenever



you believe that the processing of your data is in breach of the rules of law applicable to the personal data protection.

9. You **MUST** provide your personal data whenever the personal data processing is based on a rule of law or a contract made between the parties. Whenever the processing of your personal data is conditional upon the consent of the person involved you shall be free to decide whether to provide your data.
